Testimony of Rudolf Hoess, Commandant of Auschwitz

The first Commandant of Auschwitz was Rudolf Höss, aka Rudolf Hoess, who was given this assignment on May 1, 1940. Höss was relieved of his duties as the Commandant of the Auschwitz complex at the end of November 1943 and promoted to a position in the Economic Administration Head Office (WHVA) in Oranienburg.
